

Roger Kenneth Green

DR. ROGER KENNETH GREEN passed away on May 19, 2007, in Los Angeles, from complications of surgery. He was 58. Ken was born in Columbus, Ohio, and graduated high school in 1966 at Upper Arlington in Ohio. He attended Otterbein College and graduated in 1970 with a BA degree. Ken then joined Campus

Crusade for Christ out of college and worked with high school students for the next 15 years. For the next 17 years, Ken taught at the International School of Theology and while there he obtained his Master of Divinity degree in 1985. In 1998 he earned a Doctor of Ministry degree from Fuller Seminary. In 1984, Ken was ordained by the Evangelical Church Alliance. Ken is survived by his wife, Linda E. Dowhower Green of Redlands; daughter, Amy E. Smith of Santa Ana; sons, David Kenneth Green and Ralph William "Billy" Green of Redlands; mother, Nelda Green of Westerville, Ohio; and brothers, Eugene, Howard and Edwin all of Ohio. There will be a Viewing on Thursday, May 24th at the Trinity Evangelical Free Church at 1551 Reservoir Rd. in Redlands from 6 PM - 8 PM and a Viewing on Friday from 10 - 10:45 AM at Trinity Evangelical Free Church followed by a Memorial Service at 11:00 AM at the church. Interment will be at Hillside Memorial Park at a later date.
